4. INVITED MEMBERS

All members of V.K.S.B and F.F.P.A are invited.

The A-competition includes following categories:

- Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice (free program only)
- Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior (short and free program)

The B-competition includes following categories:

- Preminiemen, Miniemen, Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice,
- Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior

5. ENTRIES

Entries must be made using the Excel form of the federation and should be mailed to our club secretary: asw.secretariaat@gmail.com. Entries will be accepted until 16
February 2019. Registrations will not be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.

In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the participants will be determined after the closing date in accordance with V.K.S.B. competition regulations. The draw for this will take place Wednesday Februari 20th 2019. The organizing committee will confirm the participants by mail at the latest one week after closing date. An invoice will be included.

There will be no limitations for the organizing club.

6. LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU regulations, the organization committee accepts no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors.

7. MUSIC & PLANNED ELEMENTS

Planned elements and music will be used from the national database for A, B- and Adult competitions. Participants whose planned elements have changed since their last competition need to update the database (see KBKF Comm. 24 and 25.2018).

All competitors must also have a copy of their music available on CD (no CD-RW or DVD) during the event only for backup purposes. This audio CD will only contain the program music.

8. TIMETABLE

The timetable will be published as soon as possible on: www.skatebelgium.be.

For A-competition categories 'Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior': short program will be skated first (in the morning/early afternoon) and free program min. 4 hours later (in the afternoon/evening).

For each category the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition. For A-competition categories 'Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior', the starting order of the free program will be the reversed order of the short program results.

Some modifications related to the timetable can be done due to organization circumstance.

9. CATEGORIES / RULES

This competition will be conducted in accordance with the respective National A Competition Regulations, National B-competition Regulations and National Adults Competition Regulations, including all categories and subcategories, and in accordance with the VKSB Rules of Internal Order competition regulations.

The marking system will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications

An info desk will be in place in the cafetaria of the ice rink.

Competitors entered in the first scheduled category must register at the info desk upon arrival, half an hour before the start of their category at the latest. All other competitors must register one hour before the start of their category at the latest.

Coaches must visibly wear a valid trainers license to enter the neutral zone.

Photographic pictures of the skaters programs and/or awarding ceremonies will be taken by the organizing club and might be published on local and/or social media. When entering, competitors agree with taking and publishing these pictures

10. ENTRANCE FEE

55,- euro for every single skater with only free program.

80,- euro for every single skater with short and free program. (A-competition: advanced novice, junior & senior)

If payments aren't received within 14 days after invoice date the organizing club has the right to cancel or replace the skater(s) concerned.
