# **Closing date**

Entries will be accepted until Sunday 10/03/2019, 14:00h.

Inscriptions will not be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.

#### Limitations

There will be no limitations for the organizing club.

In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the participants will be determined by draw on Wednesday 13/03/2019 at 18:00h, in accordance with VKSB competition regulations.

The organizing committee will confirm the participants by mail within 1 week after the closing date, an invoice will be included.

#### **Payments**

If payments aren't received within 14 days after invoice date the organizing club has the right to cancel or replace the skater(s) concerned.

There will be **no** refund of entrance fee in case of withdraw or other. *Please keep in mind that bank transfers can take a few days*

# **Planned Elements + Music**

Planned elements and music will be used from the national database for A, Band Adult competitions. Participants whose planned elements have changed since their last competition need to update the database (see KBKF Comm. 24 and 25.2018).

All competitors must also have a copy of their music available on CD (no CD-RW or DVD) during the event only for backup purposes. This audio CD will only contain the program music.

# **Time Table**

The time table will be published as soon as possible on: www.skatebelgium.be

For A-competition categories 'Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior': short program will be skated first (on Monday morning/early afternoon, or in case of too many entries on Sunday evening) and free program min. 4 hours later (on Monday in the afternoon/evening).

For each category the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition. For A-competition categories 'Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior', the starting order of the free program will be the reversed order of the short program results.

Some modifications related to the timetable can be done due to organization circumstance.

#### Categories/Rules

This competition will be conducted in accordance with the respective National A-competition Regulations, National B-competition Regulations and National Adults Competition Regulations, including all categories and subcategories, and in accordance with the VKSB Rules of Internal Order competition regulations.

The marking system will be used in accordance with the latest ISU Communications.

An info desk will be in place in the cafeteria of the ice rink.

Competitors entered in the first scheduled category must register at the info desk upon arrival, half an hour before the start of their category at the latest. All other competitors must register one hour before the start of their category at the latest.

Coaches must visibly wear a valid trainers license to enter the neutral zone.

Photographic pictures of the skaters programs and/or awarding ceremonies will be taken by the organizing club and might be published on local and/or social media. When entering, competitors agree with taking and publishing these pictures.
