The competition is organized in co-operation with the Royal Belgian Figure Skating Federation (KBKF/FRBPA), the Flemish Skating Union (VLSU), the management of the Icerink 'IJsbaan Heist' and the village of Heist-op-den-Berg.

The competition will be held on a single day (free program only).

The competition is organized in accordance with the National B-Competition Regulations and Adults-competition Regulations, and the KBKF/FRBPA internal regulations for Belgian national competitions.

Invited members

Participation is open to all competitors who are affiliated to the Belgian Federation KBKF/FRBPA who meet the criteria as mentioned in the KBKF/FRBPA internal regulations for Belgian national competitions.

The competition is for Women and Men.

The **B-competition** includes following categories :

Preminiemen U12, Preminiemen O12, Miniemen U12, Miniemen 012, Basic Novice B, Basic Novice A, Intermediate Novice B, Intermediate Novice A, Advanced Novice B, Advanced Novice A, Junior B, Junior A and Senior A

The **Adults-competition** includes following categories :

Bronze, Silver, Gold, Master, Master Elite

Entrance Fee

The entrance fee is 75 € for single skaters.

Entries

Entries must be made using the Excel form (see http://www.skatebelgium.be/downloads.html). Please make sure to use the drop-down menus to select club and all skaters.

Closing date

Entries will be accepted until Saturday 10/02/2024 20h.

Inscriptions will **not** be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.

Limitations

In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the participants **will be determined by draw on** Tuesday 13/02/2024 at 18h30, in accordance with the KBKF/FRBPA competition regulations.

There will be no limitations for the organizing club.

The draw of the rejected entries will be random, but within the following categories in the following order:

- 1. Skaters in categories with no local club skater
- 2. All other skaters

The organizing committee will confirm the participants by mail one week after closing date at the latest.

Payments

If payments aren't received in full within 2 weeks invoice date, the organizing club has the right to cancel or replace the skater(s) concerned.

Please keep in mind that bank transfers can take a few days.

After the closing date, there will be **no refund** in case of withdrawal.

Music

Program music will be used from the national database.

Participants whose program music has changed need to update the database 10 days before the first competition day at the latest.

During the event, and only for backup purposes, all competitors must also have a **copy of their music** available on **USB-stick using the correct file format and file name format**. Audio CD's will no longer be accepted.

The organization holds the right to withdraw a skater without refund in case of an interruption caused by the lack of updated music or if the back-up music (only 1 copy allowed) can not be started within 3 minutes.

Planned Elements

Planned Elements will be used from the national database. Participants whose planned elements have changed need to update the database **10 days before the first competition day at the latest**.

Timetable

The time table will be published as soon as available on the federations website **www.skatebelgium.be**. Please (re-)check for possible changes when approaching the day of the competition.

During the competition, minor modifications related to the time table can be made due to organizational circumstances.

The timetable will also mention all Price Awarding Ceremonies.

Starting Order

For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition.

Registration

All competitors must register in person, every competition day, at the info desk upon arrival, presenting their identity card or Kids ID.

Competitors entered in the first category of the competition day must register **between 07:00 and 07:30 AM**.

All other competitors must register **one hour before the start of their category at the latest**.

Coaches must visibly wear a valid coaches license to enter the neutral zone.

Awarding Ceremony

All participants must be present in their competition costumes for the announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony.

There will be separate awarding ceremonies for the different categories.

In case of an *unannounced* absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophy or medal will be provided.

Accommodation

Skaters, coaches and supporters may book travel arrangements and accommodations individually and at their own expense.

We recommend to include a cancellation insurance in case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity.

Liability and Insurance

In accordance with ISU rules the organizing committee accepts no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors.

Technical Regulations

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest National B-competition Regulations National Adults-competition Regulations

which can be found on http://www.skatebelgium.be/regulations.html

The marking system (ISU Judging System) will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications.

Privacy regulations

The organization of this event complies to the General Data Protection Regulation legislation. Consequently, we hereby inform you that participation in our competition requires us to share personal data as follows:

- Participant list and starting order: a list of participants is shared with the judges and officials, with the audience and on <u>www.skatebelgium.be</u>. The list mentions full name, gender, category and club.
- Results: a list of participants and their detailed results is published after the competition on <u>www.skatebelgium.be</u>.

Photographic pictures of the programs and/or awarding ceremonies will be taken and published on local and/or social media for promotion purposes. When entering the competition, participants agree with taking and publishing these pictures.
