4- Entries	Entries will be accepted until Saturday February 17 th ,2019 Entries must be made using the enclosed Excel form and should be mailed to secretariaat@knherentals.be
5- Timetable	A detailed timetable will be supplied as soon as possible after the closing of entries . The timetable can also be consulted at the website of Skate Belgium .
6- Music	Every skater will provide their music for the competition by mailing it to the following mailadress secretariaat@knherentals.be by MP3 file (wetransfert). The file will be named as “ category – name skater.mp3” The music will be send before March 10 th 2019.
7- Starting order	The skaters need a CD (no rewritable) with the correct music as back up . The starting order, for each category will determined by draw .
8- Liability	The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition . According to ISU rules, skaters will participate at their own risk . The organizer can not be held responsible for accidents or damage caused by a third party .
9- Entree fee	Solo: € 25,- / skater Pair: € 35,- / pair Group / show team Small team € 40,- / team Medium team € 50,- / team Large team € 60,- / team KNH will send an invoice to the participating clubs after the closing date of the inscriptions . If payments aren't received 10 days after the invoice date, the organizing club has the right to cancel the skaters concerned . THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF ENTRANCE FEE . <p>10- Regulations</p>	<p>The choice of music is free (both instrumental and vocal)</p> <p>The content of the program is free, there are no double jumps allowed .</p> <p>The duration of the program is: Solo 2:00 – 2:30 Minutes (+/- 10 seconds) Pairs 2:00 – 2:30 Minutes (+/- 10 seconds) Group / show teams 2:30 – 6:00 Minutes (+/- 10 seconds)</p> <p>The judging panel consists of 3 judges + 1 Referee . Each judge will judging 1 element :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- Interpretation of the music 2- Transitions & Skating Skills 3- Choreography & Use of the ice <p>The marks are awarded on a scale from 1-10 and divided into thents of an point.</p> <p>The Happy Skate is a competition for recreational skaters only . The single skaters will not have participated on B_ or A- competition during the current season .</p>

Adolescent + 13 – 15 year 5. Junior + 15 – 18 year 6. Young adult + 18 - 26 year 7. Adult + 26 year <p>The age is determined at the start of the skating season (July ^{1th})</p> <p>2* Recreational Pairs mixed age :</p> <p>The participants will be divide in 3 categories:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Bronze PKA brevet 0-3 2. Silver PKA brevet 4-7 3. Gold PKA brevet 8-10 <p>The category is determed in order of the highest level of the PKA brevet . The pairs are both recreational skaters .</p> <p>3* Mixed or competitive pairs mixed age: The participants are divided in 4 categories:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Preminiemen & Miniemen 2. Novices & novice B 3. Advanced Novices & Junior 4. Senior <p>The pairs are 2 competitive skaters or 1 competitive and 1 recreational skater The category will be determined in order of the highest level of the skaters .</p>
