Entries	
-Invited members	The competition includes following categories: Categories Miniemen, Novice A, Novice B, Advanced Novice (short and free), Junior (short and free), Senior(short and free): Clubs will be invited from all over the world. The competition is for Girls and Boys and will be held on 2 days.
-Closing date	Entries will be accepted until Saturday January 2th 2016, 14:00h. Inscriptions will not be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.
-Limitations	The organisation committee will limit the entries, entries will be accepted on a first come , first served basis; up to the maximum in relation to the available ice. Following rules will be used: Every invited club has the right to enter five skaters for the category novice A & B girls. They can also enter substitutes for this category. The substitutes will be able to compete if there aren't enough competitors for the category concerned or in case of injury from an announced participant. The organising committee will inform the clubs in time in such case. There are no limitations in the other categories. Clubs subscribing seniors and juniors or boys will take precedence in completing the category novices adv. girls and novice a & b girls The organising club has the right to enter more participants. The organising club will follow the order mentioned on the entry form and there will be no further correspondence about these subscriptions. In case of a too high number of entries the organisers reserve the right to limit these entries.

-Rules	<p>Will be according the latest ISU regulations and communications.</p> <p>Miniemen: National rules (see attached form)</p> <p>Novice A/B, Advanced Novice, Junior, Senior: ISU rules.</p>
-Music	<p>All participants must provide their program music in Mp3 format before Friday January 8th 2016. Music is sent to hskmuziek@gmail.com. File name format: FS <Category> <FullName> <Time> <Category> = MIN,NOA,NOB,ADV,JUN,SEN</p> <p>Example: FS ADV John Doe 2m34.mp3</p> <p>In case of big files or grouped files, please use www.wetransfer.com. All competitors must also have a copy of their music available on CD (no CD-RW or DVD) during the event only for backup purposes. This audio CD will only contain the program music.</p>

-Time Table	<p>The time table will be published as soon as available, on the federation website www.skatebelgium.be. Please (re-)check for possible changes when approaching the day of the competition. During the competition, minor modifications related to the time table can be done due to organizational circumstances.</p>



MINIEMEN

Has not reached the age of 10 by July 1st preceding the competition for Girls and Boys.
To compete in this category a skater need to have at least Miniemen level.

Free Skating Program: 2:30 min +/- 10 sec

Warming up: 4 minutes

Vocal music is allowed in this category.

There will be no Bonus for jump elements performed in the second half of the Free program.

A well balanced Free Skating Program for Miniemen singles Girls and Boys must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump for Girls and Boys.

There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences.

Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps.

A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps,

but only the two (2) most difficult jumps will be counted.

Any single and double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in a free program. Triple jumps are not permitted.

b) There must be a maximum of 2 different spins (different abbreviation)

One (1) combination spin: the combination spin can be executed with a change of foot and a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or without a change of foot and a minimum of six (6) revs.

One (1) spin with no change of position: the spin with no change of position can be executed with a change of foot and a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or without a change of foot and a minimum of six (6) revolutions.

In both spins flying entries are NOT allowed.

The minimum of required revolutions must be counted from the entry of the spin until its exit (except final wind-up in spins in one position spin).

c) For Girls and Boys there must be one (1) step sequence with fully utilizing the ice surface.

The Program Components are only judges in:

Skating Skills

Performance/Execution

Component factor: 2.5

LEVEL EXPLANATIONS:

All elements, which are subject to levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted.

Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

If a double Axel (2A) is jumped and called by the Technical Panel (no < or <<) in the program, no deduction of -0,5 for a fall will be given, if this should be the case.

Competitors entered in the category Miniemen must register at the info desk upon arrival, 30' before the start of the competition. All other competitors must register one hour before the start of their category at the latest. Coaches must visibly wear a valid trainers license to enter the neutral zone</p> <p>For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition. The draw will be published at the info desk. The starting order of the free program (advanced novice, junior, senior) will be the reverse of the results of the short program.</p> <p>All participants must be present in their competition costumes for the announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony. The first three of each category will receive a trophy. All other participants will receive a medal. In case of absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophies or medals will be provided.</p> <p>Results will be calculated in accordance of the latest ISU regulations, with the ISU judging system with video replay.</p>

<h2>Judges</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Judge Panel -Travel and Logging 	<p>The participating members may propose a Judge qualified to at least national championship level. Entries from foreign clubs who bring a Judge with them will be preferred in case of too many entries. Names of the candidates should be made available to the organising committee before December 20th 2015. Please indicate required hotel accommodation.</p> <p>Travel expenses of foreign Judges will be reimbursed by HSK. Hotel arrangements and meals will be made and reimbursed by HSK for all drawn Judges and Referees starting with breakfast on the first competition day until dinner on the last competition day.</p> <p>Belgian Judges will receive a compensation for travel as described by the KBKF.</p>
<h2>Coaches</h2>	<p>Only named coaches on the entry form will receive a badge for entering the restricted zone.</p>
<h2>Liability and Insurance</h2>	<p>In accordance with ISU rules the organizing committee accepts no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors. In accordance with ISU rules the responsibility for health and accident insurance lies with the athletes, officials and all other members of the team. Such insurance must include full medical care and repatriation.</p>
