Limitations	Pré Miniemen: To compete in this Category, Competition level is required for a Belgian Skater.		
	Miniemen: To compete in this Category, Miniemen Figure Skating level is required for a Belgian Skater.		
	In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the participants will be determined by draw on 14/01/2023 at 20.00h, in accordance with the KBKF/FRBPA competition regulations.		
	There will be no limitations for the organizing club.

	Participants whose planned elements have changed need to update the database 10 days before the first competition day at the latest .

	Please (re-)check for possible changes when approaching the day of the competition.	
	During the competition, minor modifications related to the time table can be made due to organizational circumstances.	
	The timetable will also mention all Price Awarding Ceremonies.	
Starting Order	For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition.	
Registration	All competitors must register in person, every competition day , at the info desk upon arrival, presenting their identity card or Kids ID .	
	The PRE MINIEMEN and MINIEMEN must register	
	one hour before the start of their category at the latest.	
	Coaches must visibly wear a valid trainers license to enter the neutral zone.	



Awarding Ceremony	All participants must be present in their competition costumes for the announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony.	
	There will be an awarding ceremony for the categories PRE MINIEMEN, and MINIEMEN (during lunch break).	
	In case of absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophies or medals will be provided.	
Accommodations	Skaters, coaches and supporters may book travel arrangements and accommodations individually and at their own expense.	
	We recommend to include a cancellation insurance in case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity.	
Liability and Insurance	In accordance with ISU rules the organizing committee accepts no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors.
