Invited members

Participation in these categories is open to A, B, C, ADU competitors, affiliated to Belgian Clubs, who meet the criteria as mentioned in the KBKF/FRBPA Competition Regulations.

The competition is for Girls/Women and Boys/Men.

The A competition includes the following categories :

Basic Novice A, Intermediate Novice A, Advanced Novice A, Junior A, Senior A

The B competition includes the following categories :

Basic Novice B, Intermediate Novice B, Advanced Novice B, Junior B, Senior B

The C competition includes the following categories :

**Preminiemen U11, U14 and U18,
Miniemen U11, U14 and U18**

The Adults competition includes following categories:

Adults Bronze, Adults Silver, Adults Gold, Adults Master, Adults Master Elite

Entrance Fee

The entrance fee is 75 € (Free Skating only) and 110 € (Short Program and Free Skating).

Entries

Entries must be made using the Excel form (see <http://www.skatebelgium.be/downloads.html>). Please make sure to use the drop-down menus to select club and all skaters.

Closing date

Entries will be accepted until Friday 28/08/2026 20h.

Inscriptions will **not** be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.

Limitations

In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the participants will be determined by draw.

The draw to select the rejected Belgian entries will be conducted on **Monday August 31st 2026, 19:30**, by a KBKF/FRBPA representative according to the Competition Regulations KBKF/FRBPA. The draw will be conducted randomly, across all entries, regardless of the categories and competition types included in the competition.

Are excluded from the draw :

- entries from the organizing club;
- ANO A, JUN A and SEN A entries;
- entries of skaters who are still in possession of a wildcard from a previous draw

The organizing committee will confirm the participants by mail on **Tuesday September 8th 2026**. An invoice will be included.

Payments

If payments aren't received in full on **Monday 14/09/2026**, the organizing club has the right to cancel or replace the skater(s) concerned.

Please keep in mind that bank transfers can take a few days.

Music

Program music will be used from the **national database**.

Participants whose program music has changed need to update the database **10 days before the first competition day at the latest by sending the new program music to music@belgianfigureskating.be**

During the event, and only for backup purposes, all competitors must also have **a copy of their music** available on **USB-stick using the correct file format and file name format**. CD's or DVD's will **not** be accepted.

Planned Elements

Planned Elements will be used from the **national database**.

Participants whose planned elements have changed need to update the database **10 days before the first competition day at the latest by sending the new Planned Elements to ppc@belgianfigureskating.be**

Timetable

The time table will be published as soon as available on the federations website www.skatebelgium.be. Please (re-)check for possible changes when approaching the day of the competition.

During the competition, minor modifications related to the time table can be made due to organizational circumstances.

The timetable will also mention all Price Awarding Ceremonies.

Starting Order

For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition.

Registration

All competitors must register **in person**, at the info desk upon arrival, **presenting their identity card or Kids ID**.

Competitors entered in the first category of the competition day must register **between 07:00 and 07:30 AM**.

(The competition starts at 08:00 AM)

All other competitors must register **one hour before the start of their category at the latest**.

Coaches must visibly wear a valid coaches license to enter the neutral zone.

Awarding Ceremony

All participants must be present in their competition costumes for the announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony.

There will be separate awarding ceremonies for the different categories.

In case of an unannounced absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophy's or medals will be provided.

Accommodation

Skaters, coaches and supporters may book travel arrangements and accommodations individually and at their own expense.

We recommend to include a cancellation insurance in case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity.

Liability and Insurance

In accordance with ISU rules the organizing committee accepts no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors.

Technical Regulations

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest National A-, B-, C and Adult competition Regulations which can be found on <https://www.skatebelgium.be/regulations.html>

The marking system (ISU Judging System) will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications.

Privacy regulations

The organization of this event complies to the General Data Protection Regulation legislation. Consequently, we hereby inform you that participation in our competition requires us to share personal data as follows :

- Participant list and starting order : a list of participants is shared with the judges and officials, with the audience and on www.skatebelgium.be. The list mentions full name, gender, category and club.
- Results : a list of participants and their detailed results is published after the competition on www.skatebelgium.be.

Photographic pictures of the programs and/or awarding ceremonies will be taken and published on local and/or social media for promotion purposes. When entering the competition, participants agree with taking and publishing these pictures.
