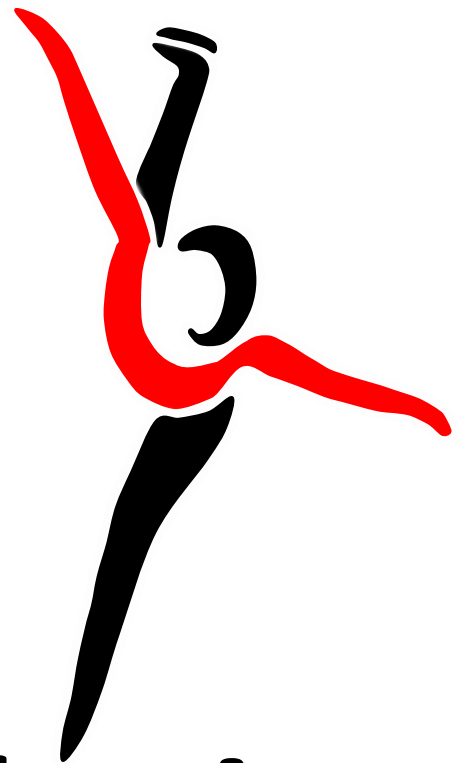

National B- and C-Competition :
Participation is open to all skaters who are member of a Belgian club.
The competition is for Girls/Women and Boys/Men.

Entries

Entries must be made using the enclosed Excel form.

Closing date

Entries will be accepted **until Saturday September 5th 2026, 23h59.**

Belgian entries will not be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.

Limitations

Foreign entries :

Foreign Entries are accepted on a “first come first served” basis up to the quota according to the Competition Regulations KBKF/FRBPA.

Belgian entries :

In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the Belgian participants will be determined by draw.

The draw to select the rejected Belgian entries will be conducted on **Monday September 7th 2026, 19:30**, by a KBKF/FRBPA representative according to the Competition Regulations KBKF/FRBPA. The draw will be conducted randomly, across all entries, regardless of the categories and competition types included in the competition.

Are excluded from the draw :

- entries from the organizing club;
- ANO A, JUN A and SEN A entries;
- entries of skaters who are still in possession of a wildcard from a previous draw

The organizing committee will confirm the participants by mail on **Tuesday September 8th 2026**. An invoice will be included.

Payments

Do not make any payments before you have received your invoice.

Payments are made only by bank transfer, using the account number and the reference mentioned on the invoice.

If payments aren't received in full on the date mentioned on the invoice, the organizing club has the right to cancel or replace the skater(s) concerned. Keep in mind that bank transfers can take a few days.

Withdrawals

After the closing date, there will be **no refund** in case of withdraw.

Withdrawals one month before the competition at the latest, because of a medical reason with implications exceeding the competition date, will be exceptionally refunded only if confirmed by a medical certificate.

Time Table

As soon as available, the time table will be published on the national federation's website www.skatebelgium.be and will also be sent to all participating clubs.

Please (re-)check for possible changes when approaching the day of the competition.

During the competition, minor modifications related to the time table can be made due to organizational circumstances.

Starting Order

For each category, the starting order will be determined by computer prior to the competition.

As soon as available, the starting order will be published on the national federation's website www.skatebelgium.be and will also be sent to all participating clubs.

The starting order for the Free Skating of ANO A, JUN A and SEN A will be in reverse order of the result of the Short Program.

Planned Elements

Planned elements will be used from the national database.

Participants whose Planned Elements have changed need to update the database 10 days before the first competition day at the latest by sending the new Planned Elements to ppc@belgianfigureskating.be

Music

Program music will be used from the national database.

Participants whose program music has changed need to update the database 10 days before the first competition day at the latest by sending the new music to [music@belgianfigureskating](mailto:music@belgianfigureskating.be)

During the event, for backup purposes only, all competitors must also have a **copy of their music** available on **USB-stick using the correct file format and file name format**. CD's or DVD's will **not** be accepted.

Registration

Competitors entered in the first category of the competition day must register at the info desk (end of the cafeteria) upon arrival, **half an hour before the start of their category at the latest**.

All other competitors must register **one hour before the start of their category at the latest**.

Coaches must visibly wear a valid trainers license to enter the neutral zone.

Awarding Ceremony

All participants must be present in their competition costumes for the announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony.

In case of absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophies or medals will be provided.

Liability and Insurance

In accordance with ISU rules the organizing committee accepts no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors.

In accordance with ISU rules the responsibility for health and accident insurance lies with the athletes, officials and all other members of the team. Such insurance must include full medical care and repatriation.

Technical Regulations

The marking system (ISU Judging System) will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications.

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest KBKF/FRBPA

Photographic pictures of the programs and/or awarding ceremonies will be taken and published on local and/or social media for promotion purposes. When entering the competition, participants agree with taking and publishing these pictures.

Accommodations and Travel Expenses

Skaters, coaches and supporters may book travel arrangements and accommodations individually and at their own expense.

We recommend to wait until the final confirmation before making any bookings in case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity.
