Ice Rink

Ice Rink 'Ruggeveld Deurne' Ruggeveldlaan 488, 2100 Deurne

The ice rink is a covered outdoor rink, skating area 60m x 29m.

Invited members

Participation is open to all competitors who are affiliated to the Belgian Federation KBKF/FRBPA who meet the criteria as mentioned in the KBKF/FRBPA internal regulations for Belgian national competitions.

The A-competition includes following categories : Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior, Senior







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Entrance Fee

The entrance fee is 60 € for single skaters.

The entrance fee is:

- 60 € for single skaters (Free Skating only).
- 90 € for single skaters (Short Program + Free Skating)

Entries

Closing date

Entries will be accepted until Saturday 21/09/2019 18:00.

Inscriptions will **not** be closed prior to the closing date, regardless the number of entries received.

Limitations

In case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity, the participants will be determined by draw on Wednesday 25/29/10 18:00 at icerink 'Ruggeveld Deurne' in accordance with the KBKF/FRBPA competition regulations.

There will be no limitations for the organizing club.

The draw of the rejected entries will be random, regardless the competition type or category.

The organizing committee will confirm the participants by mail **one week after closing date at the latest**. An invoice will be included.

Payments

If payments aren't received in full on Friday 05/10/2019, the organizing club has the right to cancel or replace the skater(s) concerned.

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Music

Program music will be used from the national database.

Participants whose program music has changed need to update the database 10 days before the first competition day at the latest.

All competitors must also have a copy of their music available

on CD (no CD-RW or DVD) or USB-stick during the event only for backup

purposes. This medium will only contain the program music.

Planned Elements

Planned Elements will be used from the national database.

Participants whose planned elements have changed need to update the

database 10 days before the first competition day at the latest.

Time Table

The time table will be published as soon as available on the federations website www.skatebelgium.be. Please (re-)check for possible changes

when approaching the day of the competition.

During the competition, minor modifications related to the time table can

be made due to organizational circumstances.

The timetable will also mention all Price Awarding Ceremonies.

Starting Order

For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw.

The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition.

Registration

All competitors must register in person, every competition day, at the info desk upon arrival, presenting their identity card or Kids ID.

Competitors entered in the first category of the competition day must

register between 07:00 and 07:30 AM.

All other competitors must register one hour before the start of their

category at the latest.

Coaches must visibly wear a valid trainers license to enter the neutral zone.

Awarding Ceremony

All participants must be present in their competition costumes for the

announcement of the results and the prize awarding ceremony.

There will be partial awarding ceremonies for the for the categories who

skated in the morning before lunch-time.

In case of absence during the awarding ceremony, no trophies or medals will

be provided.

Accommodations

Skaters, coaches and supporters may book travel arrangements and

accommodations individually and at their own expense.







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We recommend to include a cancellation insurance in case the number of entries exceeds the maximum capacity.

Liability and Insurance

In accordance with ISU rules the organizing committee accepts no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors.
