	Reliability:	In accordance with ISU regulations the organising committee accept no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors.		
	<u>Planned</u> <u>elements</u>	If an ice dance pattern will be performed, the skater(s) should provide the chosen pattern before the start of the competition.		
	sheet:	Skaters/Teams are allowed to provide a written description or introduction of each performance in the local language before the start of the competition.		
		No official planned elements sheets are required.		
	<u>Special</u> <u>remarks:</u>	 For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done by computer prior to the competition. Some modifications related to the time table can be done due to organisation circumstance; 		
		3. Each team (coach or team captain) must register at the info desk upon arrival, one hour before the start of their category at the latest		
Technical competition regulations		The music, theme and choreography are free of choice and will be determined by the skaters/team, but should be consistent with one another and give a feeling of harmony and balance. All ice dance patterns are allowed and are also free of choice by the skater(s).		
		The performance must be adapted to the dynamics of ice-skating: quality of gliding and edges, speed, ease and beauty of movements. It must also aim for proper placements and treatment of groups and variety in the use of the specific elements of skating. The number of figure skating, ice dance or synchronised skating		
		elements is not limited.		
	<u>Categories</u>	Categories will be based on the level of the skaters:		
		When at least 50% of participants has reached the following level or similar, they have to compete in the category accordingly: PKA clubtest 0 – 3 -> BRONZE category		
		PKA clubtest 4 – 7 -> SILVER category		
		PKA clubtest 8 – 10 -> GOLD category		
		National Preminiemen – Senior -> MASTER category		
	<u>Subcategories</u>	Skaters/Teams can be divided in subcategories according the following amount of skaters:		
		Solo: 1 skater (only ice dance)		
		Duo: 2 skaters		
		Small team: 3 to 8 skaters		
		Medium team: 9 to 16 skaters Large team: more than 16 skaters		
		Large team. more than 10 skaters		
	Multiple teams	Each skater is allowed to participate in different teams/categories, however the organisation will not take this into account in the composition of the timetable.		
	Music length	Performance length: max. 6 minutes for all categories.		
		Please provide us your music time asap.		
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Scenery

Costumes, accessories, scenery and props are allowed. It is however prohibited to throw confetti, paper balls, water or any other object, along with the emission of smoke and any kind of flammable matters. The use of live animals and practicable (e.g. trampolines) is prohibited.

After the announcement of the team, the skaters will have 2:00 minutes to set-up the scenery and get in their starting position.

Deductions

Judges will not deduct any points for a fall or illegal elements. A deduction of -10% of the total score will be applied for every violation of the rules e.g. overtime, prohibited scenery, late start...

Judging

The judges panel is composed of 1 referee, a technical panel and an artistic panel.

The <u>referee</u> is in charge of the judges panel and will make sure that all performances are according to the competition rules. If not, he/she will apply any necessary **deductions**.

Each judges panel awards a mark between 0 and 10, in increments of 0.25 points.

The <u>technical panel</u> will award the 1st mark 'technique of performance' based on the following criteria:

- -utilisation of the ice and the space, and the organisation of formations
- -body movements and positions
- -quality of ensembles and rapport between skaters
- -performance of technical elements
- -overall quality of skating for the team

The <u>artistic panel</u> will award the 2nd mark '**Artistic mark**' based on the following criteria:

- -presence of the skaters, intensity and impact of the performance
- -creation of a universe
- -theatricality of performance
- -originality and creativity of the performance, and its ability to be understood by the audience

In case of a tie, the second mark will determine the highest placement.

Composition judges panel

Expenses of all invited judges will be covered by the organisation. Each participating club has the right to enter one judge. This judge should be able to make a certain contribution to the judges panel, otherwise the organising club has the right to ask for a replacement. The organising club will cover all meals during the competition for this judge but will not cover any other expenses e.g. transportation.
